



FINDING FAITH: Small Group Bible Study inspired the movie by “Timeless Love”

INTRODUCTION

Timeless Love follows Lauren, a young woman whose life is transformed when she discovers her grandmother Aimee's old journal, revealing a love story that spans generations. As Lauren reads through the pages of the past, she uncovers her grandmother's journey of faith, sacrifice, and enduring love, and finds her heart being reshaped in the process. Interweaving past and present, the film explores how faithfulness in one generation echoes into the next and how true love endures the test of time. Timeless Love reminds us that all of our stories are part of a much larger story authored by a God who is faithful across every generation.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. GOD'S FAITHFULNESS ACROSS GENERATIONS

- As Lauren reads her grandmother's journal, she discovers that God's faithfulness shaped Aimee's life decades earlier, and that same faithfulness continues into Lauren's own story. How might looking back at God's past faithfulness help us think about his faithfulness in our own lives today?
- Read Psalm 100:5 and Deuteronomy 7:9. How do these passages describe the nature of God's covenant faithfulness across generations? In what ways have you seen God's faithfulness in your own family or church history?



2. LOVE ROOTED IN COMMITMENT, NOT CIRCUMSTANCE

- Aimee's story reveals a love that endured hardship, distance, or difficulty rather than a love based merely on feeling. What does it look like practically to choose commitment over feeling when love becomes difficult?
- Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 and Song of Solomon 8:6-7. How does Scripture define a love that is "timeless," and how does this differ from the world's understanding of romance? How does covenantal love, modeled ultimately in Christ's love for His church, shape how we love others?



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

3. THE LEGACY OF A GODLY LIFE



- Lauren's own heart is transformed not by a sermon or a lecture, but by witnessing the faith of her grandmother recorded in her journal. Does a lived example of faith shape us more deeply than direct instruction? Is there anyone whose lived-out faith has left that kind of mark on you?

- Read Psalm 78:4-7 and 2 Timothy 1:5. What do these passages teach us about the responsibility and privilege of passing down faith to the next generation? What steps are you taking to pass down your faith to those younger than you?

4. PROVIDENCE AND THE UNFOLDING OF GOD'S STORY

- The dual timeline of the film reveals how choices, prayers, and faithfulness in one generation quietly prepare the way for blessings in the next. Looking back on your own family or spiritual history, are there moments or people who took steps to prepare the way for those that came after them?

- Read Genesis 24:27 and Romans 8:28. How do these passages illustrate God's sovereign hand guiding the details of our lives, even when we cannot yet see the full picture? How does trusting God's providence change the way we view our present circumstances?



REFLECTION & APPLICATION

Reflect on a season in your life where God was faithful even when you couldn't see the full picture. What would it look like to actively trust that same faithfulness in a situation you're facing right now?

Is God calling you to grow in your trust in His faithfulness, your commitment to covenantal love, or your willingness to leave a lasting legacy of faith?



PRAYER

Close the Bible study with a time of prayer, inviting participants to thank God for His faithfulness to His people across generations, and to ask Him to help them love others with a steadfast, covenantal love.

Encourage them to pray for the generations to come, that God's faithfulness would continue to be known and treasured.



CONCLUSION

Like Aimee and Lauren in Timeless Love, our stories are woven into a much larger story of God's unchanging faithfulness. Encourage one another to trust that the God who was faithful to generations past remains faithful today, and that the love and faith we cultivate now will echo into the lives of those who follow after us.
