DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

2. NAVIGATING LIFE SHIFTS AND BUILDING INNER RESILIENCE

- Truhitte's life involved major transitions, from world fame in *The Sound of Music* to serving in the military, teaching students, and adapting to new chapters in life.
- How can we maintain a steady, faithful relationship with Jesus when our lives undergo drastic changes?
- Read Philippians 4:11-13 and Hebrews 13:8. How does anchoring our identity in Christ give us resilience through life's ups and downs? How can we rely on His strength during unpredictable seasons?

3. THE MINISTRY OF ENCOURAGEMENT AND MENTORSHIP



- As Truhitte shifted into teaching and mentoring others in the performing arts, his passion for music became a way to invest directly in people's lives. Who might God have uniquely prepared you to impact and mentor for the sake of Jesus and the kingdom?

- Read Hebrews 10:24-25 and 1 Thessalonians 5:11. What are practical ways we can actively mentor, encourage, or support others in our family, church, or community this week?

4. CULTIVATING GRATITUDE AND A HEART OF WORSHIP

- Throughout his long career, Truhitte maintained a lifelong love for music and a posture of appreciation for his life's path.

How does developing a lifestyle of gratitude and praise draw us closer to Jesus, especially as we reflect on God's faithfulness over time?

Read Psalm 103:1-5 and Ephesians 5:19-20. How can we practically build moments of prayer, worship, and thanksgiving into our daily routine? How does a thankful heart transform our perspective on everyday challenges?



REFLECTION & APPLICATION

Reflect on your current season of life. What gifts has God given you? Where do you need to grow in contentment? How might God have uniquely positioned you to serve others? Share specific ways you can take your gifts to Jesus in prayer, practice intentional gratitude, and invest in someone else's growth this week.



PRAYER

Close your group time by sharing things that are stopping you from living for Jesus. Thank God for the forgiveness found in Jesus, praising Him for the wonders of His abundant grace towards us, and the height, depth, width, and breadth of His love. Pray for opportunities to love those around us in our different circles, and for opportunities to share the gospel with them.
